Health, Safety, Security and Environment (HSSE) Policy

To support our vision and in accordance with our values, YWPC has implemented an HSE policy which:

- Integrates HSSE considerations into our business at all levels
- Provides the required resources to meet all HSSE requirements and strategic objectives
- Complies with all applicable legal, contractual, shareholder and industry requirements, wherever we conduct our business
- Select and engage contractors whose arrangements for HSSE management are compatible with our own
- Commits to managing our energy consumption and limits emissions in natural environments (water, air and soil), production of final waste, use of natural resources and impact on biodiversity. We continuously improve and develop processes to enhance energy efficiency and reduce environmental footprint.
- Ensures optimal use of our resources, both human and natural, to reduce our carbon footprint, prevent pollution and protect the environment
- Provides a safe and secure workplace for employees, contractors and visitors to our facilities
- Creates a positive HSSE Integrated Culture that requires individual commitment from management, employees and contractors
- Promotes healthy lifestyles, loss prevention, accident avoidance, environmental stewardship and social responsibility
- Takes appropriate actions, including injury and illness prevention and maintains the highest levels of physical, mental and social wellbeing of our employees
- Implements safety management processes which includes assessing, evaluating, eliminating or minimizing adverse HSSE risks associated with our business, workplaces operations and maintaining the integrity of our assets throughout its lifecycle
- Maintains an emergency response and crisis management system to ensure readiness and effective response to and mitigation of all possible incident scenarios
- Ensures consequent reporting of incidents and investigation and analysis of all relevant incidents to understand root causes, implement effective corrective actions and lessons learned to prevent recurrence
- Monitors the effectiveness of HSSE procedures and systems through performance metrics and evaluation with employees and contractors, to ensure continuous improvement.
- Communicates HSSE performance results and solicits input from regulatory authorities, communities, and other stakeholders
- Leads the adoption and implementation of sustainability management at all levels of our business and proactively engage with all stakeholders through the implementation of sustainability management programs and routine annual reporting.

Stop Work Policy

YWPC is committed to a policy of “If we can’t do it safely, we don’t do it!” under which we empower anyone who work or visit our sites to stop any unsafe act or condition. Any person who stops an unsafe act or condition will be protected by YWPC management from any negative consequences for such actions. The Stop Card you have been issued as part of your site induction is your mandate to stop the job on behalf of the YWPC management. Employees and contractors are empowered to stop their own work or that of others if they consider any aspect of the task or work location to be unsafe. Without exception, imminent hazards to personnel and the environment shall be promptly reported to their supervisor so that all required actions to safeguard themselves, fellow workers, property and the environment are taken quickly.

If there is any doubt, follow these steps:

• If you observe an unsafe act or condition:	→	Use the “ STOP CARD ”, reevaluate the work
• If you think an act or condition is unsafe but are unsure:	→	Use the “ STOP CARD ”, Report it to your supervisor immediately
• “If in doubt, find out”:	→	Use the “ STOP CARD ”, Don't wait until it's too late!

Failure to stop an unsafe act could endanger the life of you or your colleagues, so it is everyone’s responsibility to stop the job if you are in doubt.

If we can’t do it safely, we don’t do it!
